Research Analysis

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 3244 removes authority granted to the Oklahoma Individual Health Insurance Market Stabilization Program to levy assessments from health insurers. The measure authorizes the program's board of directors to apply for and utilize federal funding to administer a reinsurance program.

The bill repeals the following sections of Title 36 – Insurance, relating to the Oklahoma Individual Health Insurance Market Stabilization Act:

- § 6530.7. Insurer and Reinsurer Assessment
- § 6530.8. Abatement or Deferrence of Assessment
