**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB3258 grants civil immunity to any licensed engineer or architect that provides voluntary risk assessment services to a school through the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management. The risk assessment may include options for hardening a school, options for installation of storm shelters safe rooms in a school or recommendation pertaining to the best location for refuge area already existing in a school. The immunity applies to any personal injury, property damage or loss claim unless the injury or damages was caused by gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct. A licensed architect or professional engineer must possess a current license and firm certificate or authority when applicable and be in good standing with the licensing board.
