**Research Analysis**

HB3258, as introduced, grants civil immunity to any licensed engineer or architect that provides voluntary risk assessment services to a school through the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management. The risk assessment may include options for hardening a school, options for installation of storm shelters safe rooms in a school or recommendation pertaining to the best location for refuge area already existing in a school. The immunity applies to any personal injury, property damage or loss claim except for wrongful death and any injury or damages resulting from gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct.
