**Research Analysis**

The proposed Committee Substitute to HB 3260 modifies the crime of stalking by adding a definition of the word “following” to include the tracking of the movement or location of an individual through the use of a Global Positioning System (GPS) device or other monitoring device by a person, or person who acts on behalf of another, without the consent of the individual whose movement or location is being tracked. The measure exempts the lawful use of a GPS device or other monitoring device by a law enforcement agency or the parent of a minor child.
