Research Analysis

HB 3270 creates the Automated Traffic Control Systems in Highway Construction or Maintenance Zones Act. The measure allows the Department of Public Safety to establish automated traffic control systems in construction or maintenance zones established by the Department of Transportation or the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority. The penalty for a traffic violation recorded by an automated traffic control system shall be the same as otherwise provided by statute for the violation. The measure requires DPS to conduct a public information campaign to inform drivers about the use of such systems in highway construction or maintenance zones. The owner of a vehicle shall not be held liable for a traffic violation recorded by an automated traffic control system, if the driver of the vehicle at the time of the violation cannot be identified through the photograph or other recorded images obtained by the system in relation to the violation.
