**Research Analysis**

HB3284, as introduced, modifies the condition in which the court clerk is to remit a portion of any bond filing fees paid by a defendant. Currently, \$25 of each \$35 fee collected is transferred to the Sheriff's Jail Fund or a special revenue fund of the entity operating a jail. The measure makes the transfer of fees contingent upon the defendant being booked into a jail, instead of sentenced to jail.
