Research Analysis

The introduced measure replaces the current teacher residency program framework and replaces it with an induction program framework for teachers new to the profession or those transitioning to a new role within their school or district. As funds are available, the State Department of Education, in consultation with the Office of Educational Quality and Accountability, must administer the induction program as approved by the State Board of Education. The measure repeals a section of law regarding the right to a certification hearing under the current residency program.
