Research Analysis

The committee substitute modifies state subject matter standards for history, social studies, and U.S. Government by including the content of the U.S. naturalization test. The test must be made available in physical and electronic formats as an optional assessment tool for teachers. Additionally, subject matter standards for U.S. Government must include an emphasis on civics, and it adds U.S. Government to the U.S. History assessment with no less than thirty percent of the questions covering civics.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure in its current form requires the inclusion of contents from the U.S. Naturalization test in assessments for U.S. History and U.S. Government. The fiscal impact from the measure is expected to increase the cost of developing and administering the assessments by approximately \$400,000 to meet the new requirements.
