Research Analysis

HB 3331 directs the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to assist the Department of Public Safety with the maintenance of a statewide impaired driver database by transmitting to the Department criminal history records related to impaired driver arrests as they are received by the Bureau from law enforcement entities.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3331 requires OSBI to notify DPS when an individual is arrested for impaired driving. OSBI estimates the startup costs for the agency's side to the database would be:

- \$75,000 for the system development
- \$3,600 annual system maintenance cost

According to the OSBI, the total fiscal impact to OSBI would be \$78,600 for the startup first year and \$3,600 for subsequent years.
