**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 3341 requires the Secretary of the State Election Board to conduct a data validation, no later than June 30, 2019 and every two years thereafter, of the state voter registration database with other state or federal databases that contain information regarding a person's citizenship status. The Secretary is to report to the appropriate district attorney (DA) the names of any individuals registered to vote who may not be U.S. citizens. The measure directs the DA to investigate and report back to the Secretary within 60 days of the disposition of the investigation. Finally, the bill requires the Secretary to report the results of the data validation to the Governor and the Legislature.

The Committee Substitute for HB 341 requires the State Election Board to periodically conduct data validation related to the citizenship status of individuals in the state voter registration database.
