**Research Analysis**

HB 3341 requires persons registering to vote or updating a registration to provide proof of citizenship beginning January 1, 2020. Proof of citizenship can be satisfied by either a copy of the person's birth certificate, passport, naturalization documents, documentation of tribal affiliation, or other documentation established by Congress. The bill also requires individuals to provide either proof of citizenship or their voter identification card issued by the county election board in order to vote.
