**Research Analysis**

HB 3370 modifies the fine for the crime of trespass on private land devoted to farming, ranching or forestry purposes. The measure sets the fine for a first offense as not less than \$1,000. The fine for persons convicted of a second or subsequent offense is set at not less than \$2,500.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3370 changes the amount of a fine for the crime of trespassing on private land that is primarily devoted to farming, ranching, or forestry purposes. The proposed changes are below:

Offense	Current Language	Proposed Change
1 <sup>st</sup> Offense	A fine of no less than \$500, no more than \$1,000.	A fine of no less than \$1,000.
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense (et sequentes)	Misdemeanor and a fine of no less than \$1,500, no more than \$2,500 and/or imprisonment in the county jail for no less than 30 days, no more than 6 months.	Misdemeanor and a fine of no less than \$2,500 and/or imprisonment in the county jail for no less than 30 days, no more than 6 months.
