**Research Analysis**

HB 3377, as introduced, removes a requirement that an engineering or land surveying firm designate a managing agent with certain qualifications and responsibilities. In its place, the measure requires that an engineer or land surveyor designated in charge of the professional activities of the firm be a full-time employee of the firm.
