The committee substitute directs that a railroad company that fails to construct and maintain crossings in accordance with the recommendations as stated in the U.S. Department of Transportation Railroad-Highway Grade Crossing Handbook for 30 days following written notice by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission is subject to a contempt proceeding before the commission.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3388 in its current form converts a \$25.00 fine for a railroads failure to maintain crossings, to a contempt proceeding administered by the Corporation Commission. The amount of revenue generated pursuant to the provisions of HB 3388 in its current form will be dependent upon the number of identified violations and scale of contempt penalties levied by the Corporation Commission.
