**Research Analysis**

HB 3400 requires DHS to conduct a hearing within 72 hours if the revocation or denial of a child care facility license is protested; modifies the time frame for giving notice of a hearing from two weeks to 24 hours, and requires that an individual to whom an emergency order was issued be given a hearing within 72 hours after the department's receipt of such a request.
