## **Research Analysis**

The committee substitute replaces the Transportation Commission districts with the circuit engineering districts as the recipients and administrators of the funds from the County Improvements for Roads and Bridges Fund (CIRB). The measure also allows projects previously approved by the Transportation Commission prior to July 1, 2018 to continue to be funded. The measure also authorizes funds dedicated to a specific project to be used to obtain additional federal matching funds for any road or bridge project for which federal matching funds are available.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3438 in its current form modifies the board vested with the authority to establish the priority of projects funded by the County Improvements for Roads and Bridges Fund (CIRB Fund). The measure removes the Department of Transportation (ODOT) from certain duties related to the administration of CIRB projects. Potential savings could result for ODOT as a result of decreased administrative responsibilities.
