**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 3439 modifies DNA collection and test kit requirements by allowing the use of Rapid DNA testing. The measure allows for the use of Rapid DNA testing on those persons currently required to submit to the OSBI DNA Offender Database and to those booked into a facility on a felony charge.. Persons submitting to Rapid DNA testing are to be assessed a \$150 fee. The OSBI Criminalistic Services Division may approve the use of Rapid DNA systems by the Department of Corrections, a county sheriff's office, or a law enforcement agency once the FBI has approved Rapid DNA systems for use with CODIS.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3439 uses "subject to the availability of funds" and therefore the program will only exist if an adequate amount of monies are available to OSBI to enact the program requirements.

The addition of a \$150 rapid DNA fee as an alternative to the \$150 lab analysis fee will have no revenue impacts for the agency.
