Research Analysis

The measure authorizes a municipal governing board to allow a police officer who has retired under the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System, and provided written request, to retain their badge and bear firearms.

The bill would prohibit the municipality from granting the request under the following conditions:

- When the officer has been convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude;
- Where the officer is mentally or physically incapacitated and could not perform duties if recalled; and
- When the good cause is shown that granting approval of a request would be detrimental to the public health, safety, and welfare.

In the same manner and under the same conditions, a municipal governing board would be authorized to award the badge and firearm to the family of a deceased police officer.
