Research Analysis

The measure directs that funds received from a contract between a county and the Department of Justice, the Department of Corrections, or any municipality for the care of detainees in the county jail to be deposited in the Sheriff's Service Fee Account. Current law would require those funds to be deposited in a separate revolving fund with the county treasurer.

Further, the bill authorizes the sheriff to use the funds for capital expenditures.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3470 moves revenue from county jail contracts from a revolving account with the county treasurer to the county's sheriff's service fee account and authorizes it for uses other than capital expenditures. This will not impact county sheriffs' revenue.
