Research Analysis

The introduced measure creates a new section of law that directs school districts to spend no less than sixty percent of its annual budget on instructional expenditures beginning with the 2019-20 school year. If a district fails to do so it is required to increase its instructional expenditures by no less than two percent each year until the amount reaches sixty percent. If a district does not comply with the increase then the State Department will provide a written warning to the district and the district must post the notice on its website. If a district fails to comply with the provisions of the measure for two consecutive years then the district will be required to increase compensation for all teachers by two percent. This increase in compensation will be permanent.
