Research Analysis

HB 3536 expands the definition of “energy conservation measures” to include water-metering devices. The measure also extends the available repayment period of a lease-purchase agreement which funds an energy conservation contract, and removes a requirement that those contracts and agreements be let under competitive proposal procedures. The bill further removes a requirement that a state governmental entity proposing to enter into a performance-based efficiency contract consult with the State Bond Advisor.

Senate Amendments to HB 3536 clarifies language related to proposal qualifications.
