**Fiscal Analysis**

The Oklahoma Corporation Commission (Corp. Com.) anticipates the following fiscal impacts:

<b>Year 1:</b> Rulemaking, notice of inquiry, updates required to PUD Desk Manuals and Procedures, Website modifications for additional postings.	<b>50,000</b>
<b>Year 1:</b> Additional FTE to process filings and handle inquiries. Develop expertise to deal with conflict resolution and litigations (PUD, ALK, COMMISSIONERS	<b>100,000</b>
<b>TOTAL YEAR ONE</b>	<b><u>150,000</u></b>
<b>Ongoing FTE for processing and Litigation</b>	<b><u>75,000 - 150,000</u></b>

The Oklahoma Corporation Commission estimates the measure to result in additional litigation, and the actual fiscal impact could be significantly higher than this projection.
