**Research Analysis**

HB 3587 gives the Governor, Speaker of the House and Pro Tempore of the Senate the authority to remove any of their appointments to an agency, board or commission at any time, provided the appointment authority is statutory. If a gubernatorial appointment requires Senate confirmation, removal of the appointee will also require Senate approval.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3587 in its current form modifies the process whereby the Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and President Pro Tempore of the Senate fill vacancies under their appointing authorities. The measure has no direct fiscal impact of the state budget or state revenues.
