The introduced measure directs that Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP) funds remain available for a student to use to enroll in classes for a five-year period in the event that the student withdraws from a class. If the student does not reenroll during this period then the funds will become available for use by other students in OHLAP.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure provides for funds awarded through the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program to remain available to a student for five years, should the student withdraw from a class. After the time period, funds are made available for use by other students. No measureable impact is anticipated, however verification is needed from the Regents for Higher Education.
