**Research Analysis**

HB 3694 creates the State and Municipal Bail Bond Procedure Act for Nonviolent Criminal Offenses. The measure provides that any person, whether a resident of this state or a nonresident, who is arrested by a law enforcement officer solely for a state or municipal nonviolent criminal offense is to be released by the arresting officer upon personal recognizance under certain conditions.
