The proposed committee substitute to HB 3706 directs the Department of Corrections to utilize adequate amounts of its appropriated funds to maintain a per diem rate of not less than \$43.30 for private prison medium security beds.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The PCS on HB 3706:

- Stipulates the Department of Corrections (DOC) maintain per diem rates for private prison medium security beds at \$43.30 (annual total ~\$2.8 million). The only rate currently below this is a single facility which DOC pays \$40.28/day.
- Directs the agency to utilize up to \$4.8 million to coordinate with OMES in the implementation/upgrade of a statewide offender management system.
- These funds are included in the agency's FY-19 appropriation increase of \$34,433,255.
