**Fiscal Analysis**

The PCS to HB 3707 directs the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (DMHSAS) to utilize \$2M of their FY-19 budget toward the restoration of psychiatric inpatient, substance abuse residential, psychologist and agency-based therapy provider rates. The measure also directs the agency to use \$4M toward offender needs assessments and prioritizes the use of increased Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) dollars.
