The CS for HJR 1047 refers to a vote of the people an amendment to the state constitution that, if approved, will require a political party's candidate for Governor to designate an individual to run as the Lieutenant Governor on the same ticket. This change will be effective beginning with the 2022 General Election.

Fiscal Analysis

HJR 1047 in its current form would send to the vote of the people an amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution that would require Governor and Lieutenant Governor candidates to run on the same ticket. The measure makes no change to either official's compensation, powers, or duties; therefore, the measure is not expected to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
