Research Analysis

SB 1017 directs the court, in any action related to awarding or modifying custody of a minor child when it is in the child's best interest to: encourage the parents to promote a close relationship between the child and both parents; minimize the child's exposure to parental conflict; and to cooperate with each other in matters relating to the child. Finally, the measure provides that parental behavior that attempts to alienate a child from the other parent is grounds for modification of the custody order.
