The engrossed measure directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to seek a Medicaid waiver to pursue modifications to eligibility criteria so that eligibility for the parent/caretaker group, relative to the federal poverty guidelines, is reduced to twenty percent.

**Fiscal Analysis**

According to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, reducing the federal poverty level for the Medicaid population would result in an estimated reduction of \$203M (\$118, 898,915 in federal dollars and \$84,104,184 state share).
