**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute directs the Chief Information Officer to approve the purchasing of all information technology and telecommunication services for all state agencies with the following exceptions:

- A purchase of less than or equal to \$5,000 if the product is purchased using a state purchase card and the product is listed on either the Approved Hardware or Approved Software list located on the Office of Management and Enterprise Services website; or
- A purchase over \$5,000 and less than \$25,000 if the product is purchased using a state purchase card, the product is listed on an information technology or telecommunication statewide contract, and the product is listed on either the Approved Hardware or Approved Software list located on the Office of Management and Enterprise Services website.
