## **Research Analysis**

SB 1078 adds fentanyl to the list of substances subject to trafficking penalties. The measure provides that possession of one gram or more of a mixture containing fentanyl or carfentanil, or any fentanyl analogs or derivatives shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$100,000 and not more than \$500,000.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1078, which adds fentanyl to the list of substances subject to the penalties of the Trafficking in Illegal Drugs Act, widens the scope of a felony which could increase the statewide incarceration rate. Currently the average cost of incarceration for one individual in DOC custody is \$58.70/day or \$21,425.50/year. The measure also establishes a fine between \$100,000 and \$500,000. Ultimately the exact impact is contingent upon how many individuals are convicted of the crime and the amount of the fine they are mandated to pay.
