**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1098, which creates the Criminal Justice Reclassification Coordination Council, provides for travel reimbursement for members from their respective organizations according to the Oklahoma State Travel Reimbursement Act. The ultimate reimbursement impact is contingent upon how many meetings are held and amounts of reimbursement applied for. The measure also stipulates that the Office of the Attorney General will provide administrative support. This could increase the agency's workload and/or administrative costs; however, this impact is most likely minimal.
