Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to SB 1098 creates the Criminal Justice Reclassification Coordination Council. The 21 member council is to recommend to the Legislature the classification of all felonies into appropriate categories; recommend appropriate sentence lengths for each class of felonies; recommend appropriate enhanced sentences for crimes committed after prior convictions; and recommend other appropriate changes to improve the criminal justice system in Oklahoma and ensure the pubic safety of its citizens.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1098, which creates the Criminal Justice Reclassification Coordination Council, provides for travel reimbursement for members from their respective organizations according to the Oklahoma State Travel Reimbursement Act. The ultimate reimbursement impact is contingent upon how many meetings are held and amounts of reimbursement applied for. The measure also stipulates that the Office of the Attorney General will provide administrative support. This could increase the agency's workload and/or administrative costs; however, this impact is most likely minimal.
