Research Analysis

SB 1128 requires all providers, group purchasers, prescribers, and dispensers of controlled substances to establish, maintain, and use an electronic prescription drug program by January 1, 2021. The measure requires prescribers and dispensers to use the NCPDP SCRIPT Standard for the communication of prescription information. The measure requires the Commissioner of Health to develop a uniform formulary exception form to allow health care providers to request exceptions from group purchaser formularies.
