**Research Analysis**

The measure modifies the terms and salaries of the secretaries of the county election boards. Beginning on May 1, 2019, the terms would increase from two years to four years. The salaries would increase in two steps. The first beginning on May 1, 2019 and ending on April, 2023 and the second beginning on May 1, 2023.
