## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1131 creates the Oklahoma State Safety Oversight Program within the Oklahoma Department of Transportation. Officials from ODOT maintain that creation of the Program is required as part of a federal certification process related to transit program funding, and that no state funds would be involved in the administration of the program. SB 1131 has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or state revenues.
