Research Analysis

SB 1140 prohibits private child-placing agencies from being required to participate in any placement of a child that violates the agency's written religious or moral convictions or policies. The bill further prohibits DHS from denying or revoking an agency's license, and prohibits a state or local government entity from denying a grant or contract to an agency, based on its refusal to participate in the placement of a child that violates its policies.
