Research Analysis

SB 1165 makes it unlawful to knowingly authorize or permit a motor vehicle owned or under the control of that person which is not equipped with an ignition interlock device to be driven upon any street or highway of this state by any person who is required to have an ignition interlock device installed upon the vehicle.

The measure repeals Title 47, Section 11-902a relating to Allowing Use of Motor Vehicle Without Ignition Interlock Device – Penalty, which was found unconstitutional by *Hunsucker v. Fallin*

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1165 establishes 3 misdemeanors punishable with a fine up to \$500. The ultimate impact is contingent upon how many individuals are convicted and the amount of the fines they are required to pay.
