Research Analysis

The engrossed measure prohibits reimbursement through Medicaid or any other federal or state program if a provider, or any affiliate of that provider, has been found guilty of trafficking fetal body parts. A provider may reapply for reimbursement after five years and after they've demonstrated they no longer traffic fetal body parts. Within 60 days of receiving a complaint, the Health Care Authority must publish any investigative findings and issue a determination.
