**Fiscal Analysis**

The amendment to the amendment includes provision for certain property to subject to the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act. The Act provides for the State Treasurer to deduct a reasonable service charges not to exceed four percent (4%) of the monies accruing to the state under the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act, which may be used to defray the administrative costs, including costs necessary to retain legal counsel to ensure compliance with the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act.
