**Research Analysis**

The engrossed measure modifies provisions related to Podiatric Medicine Practice Act and the Oklahoma Licensed Perfusionist Act. It authorizes the use of an electronic application for the podiatry licensing exam and stipulates that a person taking the exam must be legally in the U.S. It strikes language regarding a person being free from contagious or infectious disease and authorizes the podiatry board to review applications by circularization and to vote to approve an application. The approval vote must be unanimous and no application may be denied except in a meeting of the board upon a majority vote. Applications approved by circulation must be ratified at a subsequent meeting of the board. Lastly, the measure authorizes the State Board of Examiners of Perfusionists to review applications by circularization and to vote to approve an application. The approval vote must be unanimous and no application may be denied except in a meeting of the board upon a majority vote. Applications approved by circulation must be ratified at a subsequent meeting of the board.
