**Research Analysis**

The engrossed measure prohibits public schools from combining the Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committee with the Safe School Committee. The measure modifies the definition of *bullying* and adds a definition for *power imbalance*. School sites must publicize information about the Safe School Committee and the committee must meet at least once each semester. The measure directs the State Department of Education to promulgate rules to monitor the compliance and authorizes the department to report a school as deficient on the accreditation report for noncompliance.
