**Research Analysis**

The engrossed measure directs the State Board of Education to adopt a timeline for transition to the electronic delivery system for state testing. A school district may make a request to the board to offer printed assessments. The State Department of Education will publicize when school districts must make a request.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure requires the State Board of Education to deliver assessments to districts electronically and approval from the SBE if the districts requests printed assessments. By migrating to electronic delivery for grades 3-8 testing, the State Department of Education anticipates a savings of approximately \$2.6 million over a five year period.
