Research Analysis

SB 1304 directs the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation and Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control to collaborate, leverage resources, consolidate investigative services where applicable, promote efficiencies and provide enhanced services in the State of Oklahoma, including the sharing of the Augmented Criminal Investigative Support System Case Management System; consolidating regional office and laboratory space, combining training elements to avoid duplication; and implement a shared usage policy of unmanned aircraft systems and other technology.
