The proposed Committee Substitute to SB 1305 provides that when the prison capacity exceeds 95% the Pardon and Parole Board is to immediately consider for parole any person incarcerated for a nonviolent offense and who is within six months of their statutory parole eligibility date.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 1305, upon review by DOC, is determined to have a minimal to significant impact on the agency's costs. The exact cost savings will be contingent upon how many incarcerated individuals are approved for parole by the Pardon and Parole Board. The current average cost of incarceration for one individual in DOC custody for the state is \$58.70/day or \$21,425.50/year.
