**Research Analysis**

The FA1 to SB 1336 adds an emergency clause.

SB 1336 modifies the hours during which alcoholic beverages may be sold. The measure provides that no alcoholic beverages may be sold between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. Municipalities may enact ordinances requiring such premises to be closed to the public between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
