**Research Analysis**

The first floor amendment directs the State Board of Career and Technology Education to create a list of accepted industry-valued credentials that will be reviewed annually and updated every three years. The list will be utilized for the modified mathematics curriculum unit.

The measure requires the parent or legal guardian of a student who is under the age of 18 to meet with a school designee prior to their enrollment in the core curriculum. It modifies the mathematics curriculum unit to allow for the successful completion of a one year of full-time, three-hour career and technology program leading to an industry credential/certificate or college credit. It also specifies that any other mathematics course with content and/or rigor equal to or above Algebra 1 may count as a mathematics unit.
