Research Analysis

The engrossed measure updates the Oklahoma Chiropractic Act by:

- Modifying definitions;
- Changes the issuance of renewal licenses from the by January 1 to July 1;
- Stipulating the forfeiture, nonrenewal, surrender or voluntary relinquishment of license does not bar the chiropractic board from proceeding with any investigation, action or proceeding to revoke, suspend, condition or limit a licensee's license or fine them;
- Modifying requirements for licensure including appearing before board for a personal interview if requested;
- Stipulating under what conditions the board may deny or impose probationary conditions upon an applicant;
- Modifying the timeframe for the board to approve or reject a continuing education seminar from no later than 30 days to 60 calendar days;
- Stipulating that the board may require a licensee to make up continuing education hours in the succeeding year as condition for license renewal when the continuing education requirements are waived for any given year; and
- Providing that a chiropractic physician that is not in compliance with state income tax laws cannot have their license renewed.
