**Research Analysis**

SB 1388 establishes processes and procedures for installation by a wireless service provider of small wireless facilities and utility poles in rights-of-way. The bill gives a wireless provider the right to collocate small wireless facilities and install, maintain, modify, operate and replace utility poles along, across, on, or underneath rights-of-way. The measure prohibits a municipal electric authority from entering into an exclusive arrangement with a person for use of rights-of-way for collocation of small wireless facilities or utility poles.

The bill requires a wireless provider to comply with reasonable and nondiscriminatory requirements prohibiting communication service providers from installing structures in rights-of-way in areas designated solely for underground or buried cable and facilities.
